I am writing to you on behalf of the Rushmoor Development Partnership (RDP) to invite you to take part in the next phase of consultation for the Civic Quarter, and ask for your help in spreading the word and encouraging people to give their feedback.

As you may know, the RDP, a partnership between Rushmoor Borough Council and development partner, Hill Partnership Ltd, is bringing forward proposals to regenerate the Civic Quarter site just south of the town centre into a vibrant new heart for Farnborough.

The Civic Quarter regeneration proposals would see the current site transformed into a mixed-use space with new opportunities for town centre living, alongside ground floor spaces for cafes and restaurants, a library, and community space. It would also enable creation of Rushmoor Borough Council's separate plans to provide a new leisure centre.

Eight key objectives for the redevelopment were established following the public consultation in 2019, and as we look to refine the Civic Quarter masterplan further, we would like to hear your thoughts on what should be prioritised in the plans, and what you think is important to include for the benefit of the town.
